A Green Garden Oasis

The Traditional Korean Forest, consisting of native Korean trees and plants is a place where visitors can enjoy a taste of fresh air in downtown Seoul. The Natural Ecological Forest features an ecological pond and trees that allow visitors to learn more about nature.



Culture Courtyard

Featuring a smooth hill blanketed with green grass, a walking path and a pond, the Culture Yard is a place where visitors can rest and enjoy seasonal colors all year round. It also serves as a venue for diverse events, including performances, mass meetings and artistic activities.



Bike Riding

Ride a bike along the 2.9-km bike road encircling evergreen Yeouido Park with a soft breeze at your face.



Yeouido, the Heart of Korea's Politics, Economy and Public Opinion

Yeouido is home to the National Assembly, the 63 Building with observatory and aquarium, and several broadcasting TV and radio networks. The Hangang Cruise Ship sails regularly along the river.

A Story about Yeouido Park



♣ Yeouido is an alluvial island in the Hangang (River) that was used as a horse ranch in the Goryeo Dynasty (918-1392) and as pasture or farmland in the Joseon Dynasty (1392-1910).

♣ A temporary airport was constructed in Yeouido in 1916 and Korea's first pilot Ahn Chang-nam performed flight demonstrations in celebration of his visit to Korea in 1922.

♣ With the completion of Gimpo International Airport in 1958, Yeouido later served as an air force base. In 1971, Yeouido Plaza replaced the runway, becoming a venue for large-scale events on Armed Forces Day and other special days and later a site for bike riding, roller skating and other leisurely activities for the public.

♣ In 1999, Seoul City removed the dark asphalt and turned the area into a green park with four zones: Traditional Korean Forest, Lawn Field, Culture Courtyard and Natural Ecological Forest.

How to Enjoy Yeouido Park ^ - ^



Ecology Pond

A place where visitors can observe nature through diverse organisms living in the pond.



Cultural Event Plaza

A venue for various performances, rallies, and other events open to the public.



Samojeong

Standing in the Traditional Korean Forest, Samojeong is a pavilion that overlooks the traditional pond Jidang.



Yeouijeong(Octagonal Pavilion)

A traditional-style pavilion that overlooks the Traditional Korean Forest and leads to a stream.

Bike road and walking trail

The bike road and walking trail circle the park and are linked to Hangang Park via the underpass. (bike road: 2.9 km, walking trail: 2.5 km)



National flagpole

The 50 m-tall landmark allows visitors to see the national flag from anywhere in the park.



The Statue of King Sejong the Great

The statue records King Sejong's achievements, including the proclamation of Hunminjeongeum. Also, replicas of King Sejong's inventions are on display, including the celestial globe ("Honcheonui"), water clock ("Jagyegokru"), and sundial ("Angbulgi").




Jidang

Jidang is a traditional-style pond that consists of pond, stream, and path. It has three small artificial islands that symbolize the past, present, and future.






