Garden City Seoul brings nature and urban culture together, enriching everyday life.



The 2026 Seoul International Garden Show unfolds across Seoul Forest, the Hangang River, and Seongsu-dong, bringing together 167 diverse gardens. As each space connects in a continuous line, the park is no longer seen as a series of separate points but as a single continuous flow embracing the city as a whole.

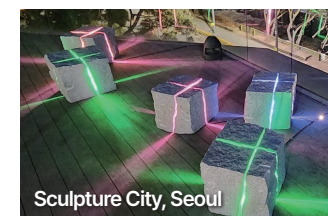

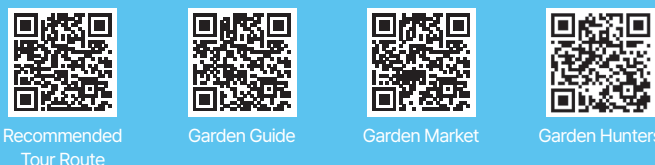

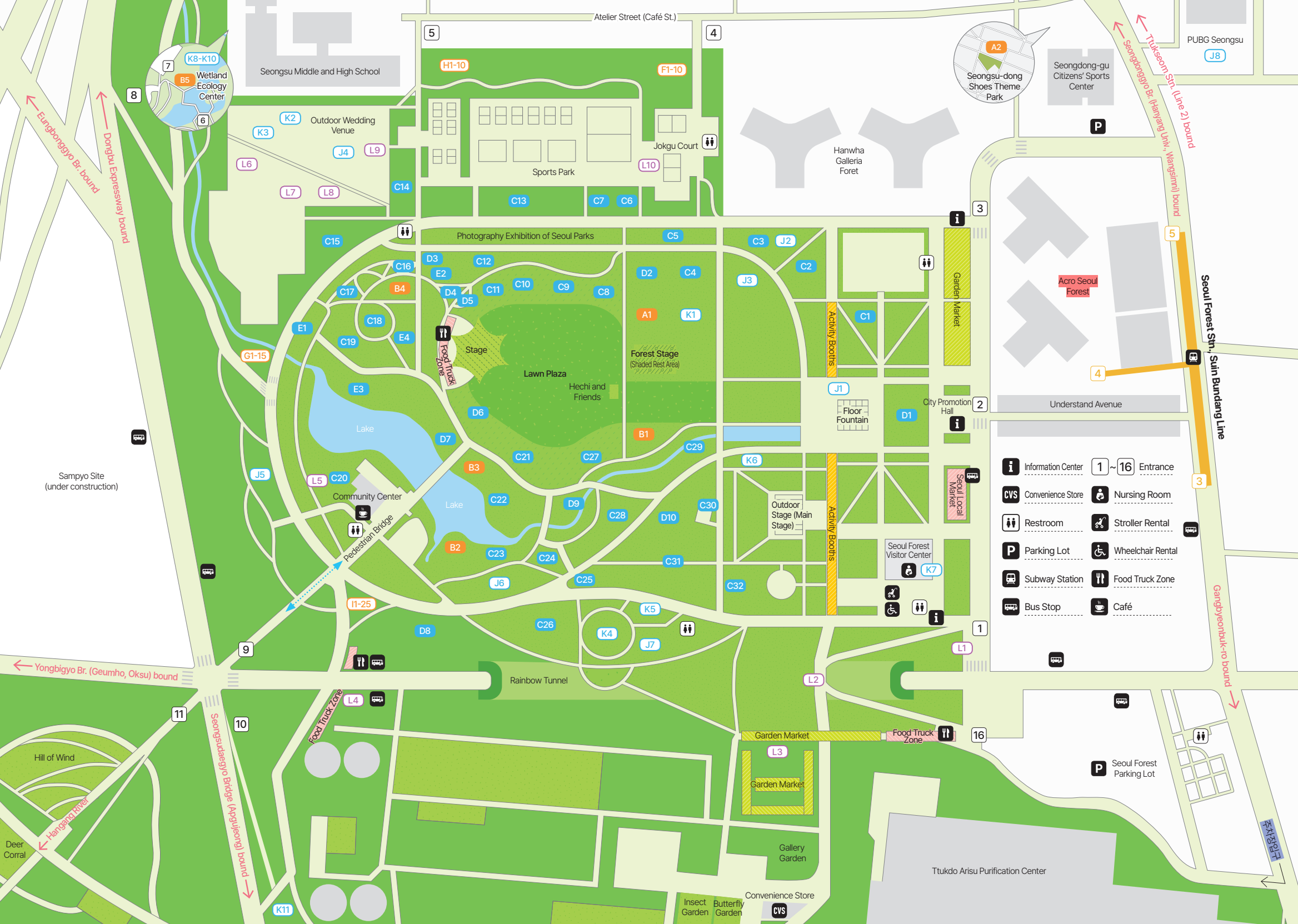
